

EFG Summer Camp SCHOLARSHIP

Criteria

1. The EFG Summer Camp Scholarship Program provides educational financial incentives to K-11 students to attend camps, seminars, and institutes.
2. Grants are provided up to \$300. Grants will be awarded once a year (in the spring). Applications are due by **March 1st** of each year. If March 1 falls on a weekend, they will be due the following Monday.
3. Students interested in an EFG Summer Camp Scholarship must submit the following:
 - a. An application to the Education Foundation of Greenville (application can be obtained at the Central Services Office or at any school building office).
 - b. On the reverse side of the application, **type** a short statement (**no hand-written statements, please**) on why you would like to receive this scholarship and what impact you think this experience will have on you.
 - c. A letter of reference must be submitted with the application from a non-relative, employer, advisor, or teacher (the teacher cannot be the same one who signs the endorsement part of the application).
 - d. The application must be signed by parent/guardian.
 - e. A brochure or other printed information must accompany the application with information about the camp, institution, etc. .Printed copies of a camp website are acceptable.
4. Teacher Endorsement. The application must include a signature of a teacher who endorses the student as an appropriate candidate to attend the requested activity.
5. Scholarship awards will be based on need, application information, letter of reference, teacher endorsement, and camp information. Consideration will be given to students who attempt to raise their own funds.
6. Scholarships will not be awarded for private lessons, beauty pageants, or trips.

Please understand that funding may not allow the Foundation to award each and every grant.
